



School Organisation – Public Notice

Proposal to change the age range of St Michael's C of E, VA, Nursery and Infant School to admit pupils from 4 up to the age of 11 in the main school

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that the Governing Body, St Michael's C of E, VA, Nursery and Infant School, Schoolhouse Lane, Blickling Road, Aylsham, intends to make a prescribed alteration to change the age range of the school from 4 to 7 to 4 to 11 from 1st September 2018.

The current capacity of the school is 108 and the proposed capacity will be 140. The current admission number for the school is 36 and the proposed admission number will be 20.

The Governing Body of the school will implement this proposal.

This proposal – traffic implications

The aim is for the school to grow by one class. Research shows that as children grow older they are more able to walk to school and are less reliant on lifts. The need for parents to rush between St Michael's and Bure Valley School at the beginning and end of the school day will also be eliminated. Through our travel strategy we intend to make sure that local residents and businesses don't suffer any further inconvenience.

All statutory consultation requirements relating to this proposal have been complied with.
