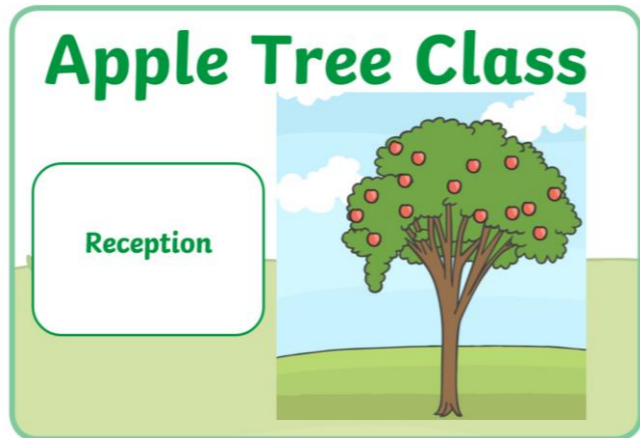

Literacy

Children will learn to write some or all of their name and start to develop their handwriting. They will explore early writing for different purposes in their play and look at books in all areas of the classroom.

Children will learn the first set of phase 2 letters sounds and develop an awareness of environmental sounds, rhyme and alliteration.

Maths

We will be focusing on recognising, forming and subitising (*being able to say how many objects there are without counting them*) numbers 1-3. We will be identifying more/less and looking at 2 step repeating patterns. They will be comparing different sizes and amounts using comparative language- bigger/smaller and taller/shorter etc. and sorting them into groups.

Science

- Children will learn to recognise the signs of Autumn and that it contains 3 months – Sept, Oct, Nov.
- Children will learn that the leaves on trees change colour and fall off. They will learn the days get shorter.
- They will learn where milk comes from and how to make butter. They will learn how flour is made and make bread.
- Children will learn that humans have 5 senses – hearing, sight, smell, taste and touch. They will be able to give examples of how we use each sense.

RE

Children will consider their own uniqueness and explore a range of different feelings.

Communication & Language

The children will start by learning the routines of Apple Tree Class and how to follow instructions. They will listen to simple stories, joining in and retelling them. They will be learning songs and rhymes. They will be encouraged to initiate conversations with other children and adults, using an increased range of words.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will learn to manage themselves, putting on their coats and shoes and going to the toilet etc. They will try new things and talk about how they are feeling. Children will build relationships with other children and adults

Geography or History

History

- Children will learn that we have harvest festival to celebrate the food that grows on the land and how farming has changed over the years.
- Children will be able to discuss the similarities and differences between artefacts from now and then - farming machinery.

Geography

- Children will learn that home is in Aylsham and Aylsham is in England.
- Children will learn that there are different countries in the world.
- Children will learn how people celebrate harvest festival in America, Africa, India and China.

Art & Design or Design & Technology

- Children will learn how to mix paint to make different colours.
- Children will recognise and name the primary colours.
- Children will learn to use a variety of tools – sponges, brushes, fingers, twigs etc.
- Children will learn to draw self-portraits.
- Children will learn how to make a fruit salad and taste unusual fruit.
- They will make pumpkin soup and chop the pumpkin.
