Acceptable Use Policy (Internet Use)

- All Internet access at our school is filtered to exclude undesirable sites. This filter can only be modified by the ICT technician.
- Children and staff will never reveal their personal details, home addresses or telephone numbers on the web or in dialogue with other Internet users.
- Children will only engage in conversation or dialogue with other users on the Internet with permission or under supervision.
- The free use of search engines is not permitted, unless a member of staff is supervising.
- Children are taught to report immediately to a member of staff if they find themselves uncomfortable or upset by anything they discover on the Internet.
- Downloading of files is restricted to staff, or children under supervision.
- In the interests of safety and security, the school keeps detailed log of all sites visited by each and every user within the school.

Use of digital and video images

To comply with the Data Protection Act 2018, we need your permission before we can photograph or make recordings of your child.

We follow the following rules for any external use of digital images:

If the pupil is named, we avoid using their photograph.

If their photograph is used, we avoid naming the pupil.

Where showcasing examples of pupils' work we only use their first names, rather than their full names.

If showcasing digital video work to an external audience, we take care to ensure that pupils aren't referred to by name on the video, and that pupils' full names aren't given in credits at the end of the film.

Only images of pupils in suitable dress are used.

Staff only take photographs or videos on personal equipment with prior permission from the head teacher. Photographs are downloaded from equipment daily and then deleted from the equipment. Photographs or filming will only take place with the permission from the head teacher and under supervision of a member of staff.

Volunteers and parent helpers in school or on trips are not permitted to take photographs of the children.

We request that photographs taken at school events by parents and carers are not shared on social media.

Examples of photograph or video us:

- In the classroom to enhance learning activities.
- For school noticeboards, newsletters, the website, social media, local press.
- With the local authority or local schools to share good practice and celebrate success.

Note: if we, or you, actually wanted your child's image linked to their name we would contact you separately for permission, e.g. if your child won a national competition and wanted to be named in local or government literature.
