Animal Adventures

Communication, language and Literacy

The children will be learning about the features of a book, such as the front and back cover, blurb, title, contents page and page numbers etc. They will practise making their own sentences verbally and writing sentences with a capital letter, finger spaces and a full stop.

Personal Social and emotional development

The children will be sharing their own opinions whilst remaining respectful of others. They will be talking about the perspectives of others.

Physical Development

In our PE sessions on Mondays we will be performing short dances to the theme of dinosaurs. The children will continue activities to strengthen their fingers for writing and practice good pencil/fine motor control.

Mathematics

We will be focusing on building numbers beyond 10, ordering numbers to 10 and beyond. We will be using addition and subtraction in real life/story situations. We will be looking at arrangements of shapes and how they can fit together.

RE

The children will be exploring their ideas of god. They will learn about the Christian belief that God exists in human form in the person of Jesus.

Understanding the World

This half term we will be learning about summer season. We will be looking at maps of the UK and learning the different countries and finding the places they know. We will learn about tigers, we will learn about India and the people who live there. We will also learn about Amelia Earhart and transport in the past. We will be learning about Meerkats and Africa.

Expressive Art and Design

We will be look at the ways animals use patterns on their skin and fur to camouflage and try to replicate this in different media. We will look at materials from India and use these as a starting point for our art. We will look at art from Africa and create our own patterns.
