English

This half term we will begin by writing narratives based upon the classical story of The Jungle Book. We will then move onto persuasive letters before finally writing a non-fiction text about a country within Asia.

Maths

Both year groups will start the half term by looking at negative numbers before moving onto measurement conversions and volume. For the final few weeks, we will be combining knowledge taught across the year to focus on problem solving.

Science

Our science unit this half term is forces! We are going to experiment with gravity; test air resistance; as well as putting our DT knowledge from Autumn to the test as we examine different pulleys and levers.

RE

This half term our RE focus question is: How do Muslims' beliefs impact their identity. We will recap the core beliefs of Islam and look more in depth at the 5 pillars of Islam. We will analysis parts of the Quar'an and discuss how it would help shape the lives of Muslims today.

PE

PE will be on Monday and Wednesday each week so please send your children to school in PE kit on these days. Monday is outdoor PE focusing on athletics. Wednesday's PE will be swimming at the high school for Year 6. The Year 5s will have PE focused on PE leadership.

Outdoor Explorers or Computing and Music

This half term we will have computing and music. In Computing, we will be expanding our knowledge and understanding of coding. In Music, we will be looking at lullabies, specifically Baloo Baleerie.

Geography or History

This half term we will be focusing on Geography. The class will begin by exploring the continent of Asia and it's many countries. We will then look at physical features and cultural life.

Art & Design or Design & Technology

This half term we will focus on Art. We are focusing on the local artist: Kieron Williamson. Taking inspiration from his sea landscapes, we will explore his use of lines and textures to create water scenes before recreating our own.
