Focus Texts



Communication, language and Literacy

In our group session we do short activities that develop focused listening and attention.

We will be learning a new Nursery rhyme each week

Personal Social and emotional development

We will be supporting children to understand their emotions through stories.

We will continue working on independence, and supporting new starters. Children will practice putting on their coats and shoes.

Physical Development

We will supporting children to develop their gross and fine motor skills daily through play and activities.

Mathematics

In our group sessions we will be developing spatial awareness. Looking at Measure recognising attributes and using vocabulary to label them

We will be Introducing a range of images and objects representing numbers 1-3. Recognising small quantities (up to 3) without needing to count them all (subitises)
We will be Saying number words in sequence (to 5, extending to 10)

We will be looking at patterns in the environment
Continuing repeating patterns
