### English

This half term we will be exploring setting descriptions. The children look at how to create a detailed and descriptive text that is enticing and engaging. The children will use their senses to aid their descriptions.

### Maths

This half-term the main focus in maths is all around operations and fractions.

We will be learning the different methods used to solve addition, subtraction, multiplication and division problems.

The children will move onto exploring ratio and how it is used and works.

### Science

Our science topic is light. The children will look at how light works and how light travels. The children will conduct several investigations that explore light.

### PSHE

In PSHE this half term we will be learning about Zones of Regulation. We will explore vocabulary relating to emotions and learn to recognise different emotions in ourselves and others. We will also become more aware of triggers which lead us to feeling less regulated.

### PE

We will have PE on Wednesday afternoons, We will have one inside lesson and one outside lesson each Tuesday afternoon.

### Computing and Music

This half term will be doing music where will be looking at different forms of instrumental and vocal music.

### Geography or History

In History we will be exploring Royalty. The children will look into famous events such as the Battle of Hastings and how William the Conqueror won the battle.

In Design this half term the children will be exploring sewing where the children will be looking into different skills and knowledge around the topic.
