English

This half term we will be exploring writing a balanced argument and story writing. The children will learn the different skills need to write an explanation text (focusing on volcanoes)

Maths

This half-term the main focus in maths is area and perimeter. Children will look at finding and measuring area and perimeter.

We will also focus on statistics which will include organising data and representing data in different ways.

Science

Our science topic is scientists and inventors. The class will learn about different people and what they did.

PSHE

In PSHE this half term we will be revisiting our learning about Zones of Regulation. We will explore vocabulary relating to emotions and learn to recognise different emotions in ourselves and others. Children will work on a range of strategies to aid them when dealing with different emotions and feelings.

PE

We will have PE on Wednesday afternoons, We will have one inside lesson and one outside lesson each Tuesday afternoon.

This term the Year 5's will be swimming.

Computing and Music

This half term will be doing music, the class will use a range of instruments to copy and then create their own piece of music.

Geography or History

In History we are looking at Ancient Romans in Britain. The children will explore what Roman life was like and how they ended up getting to Britain. Children will also explore what made their empire so great and how their leaders become so successful.

Art & Design or Design & Technology

In art this half term the children will be creating their own statues using clay to represent a Roman Emperor.
